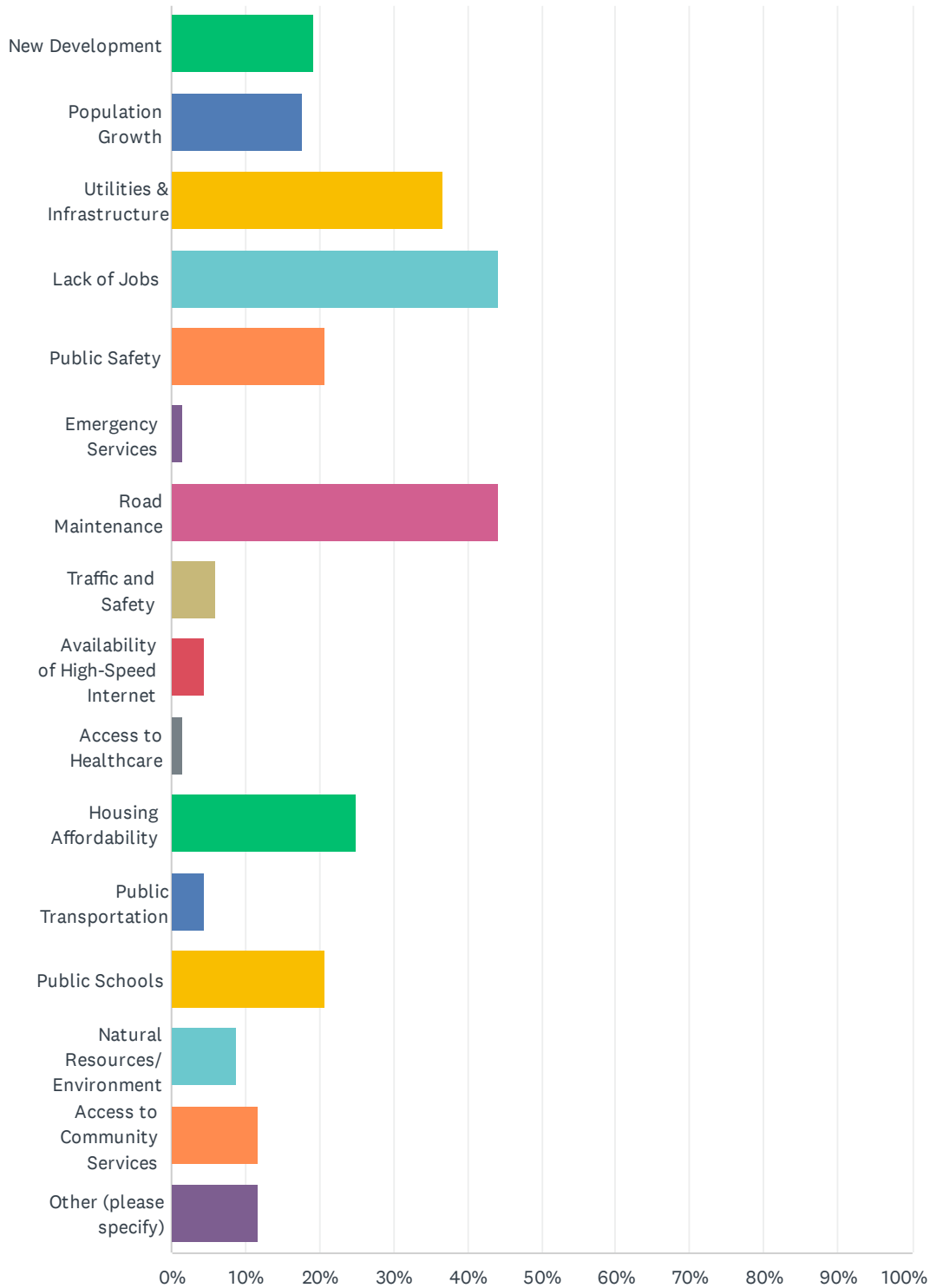

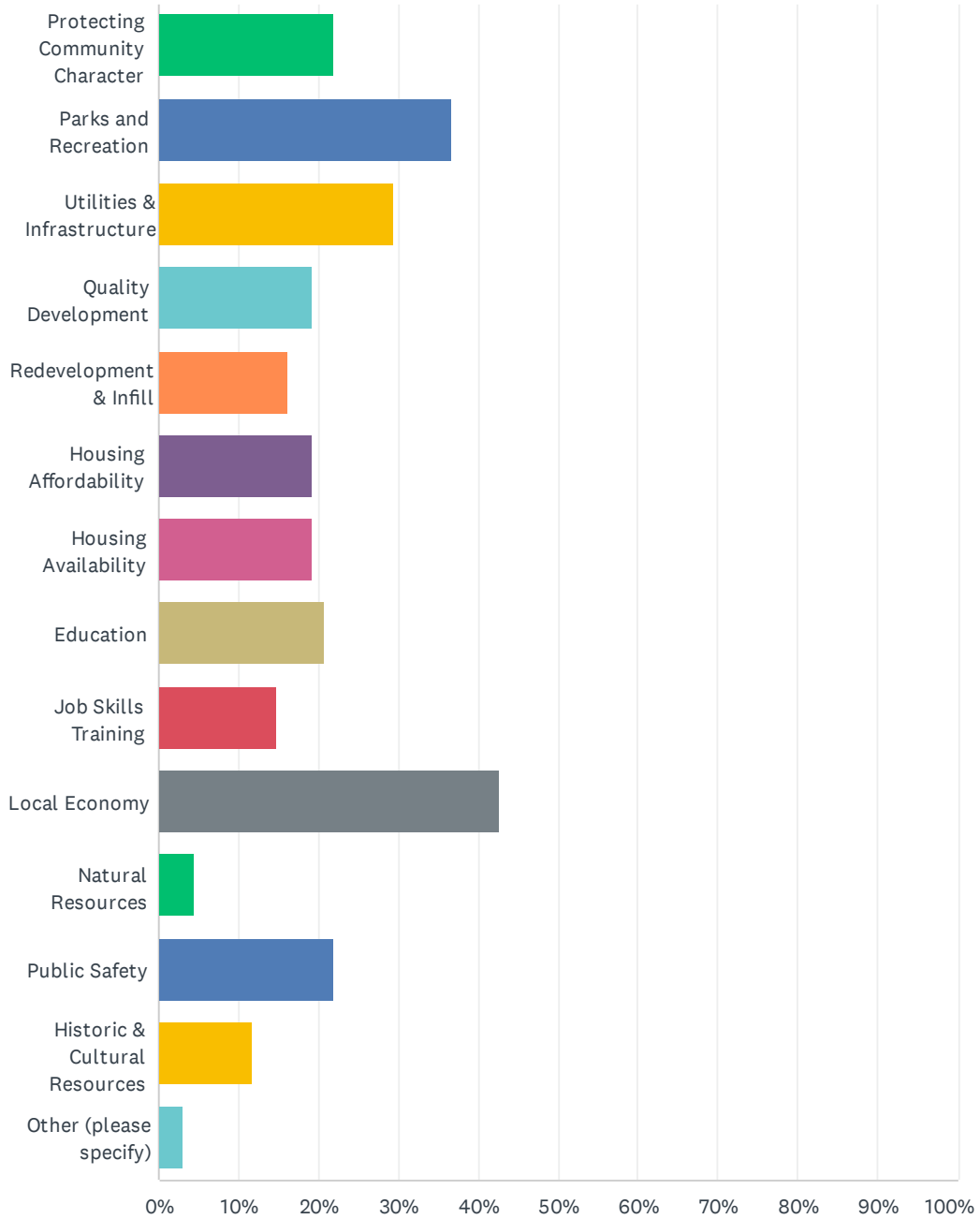

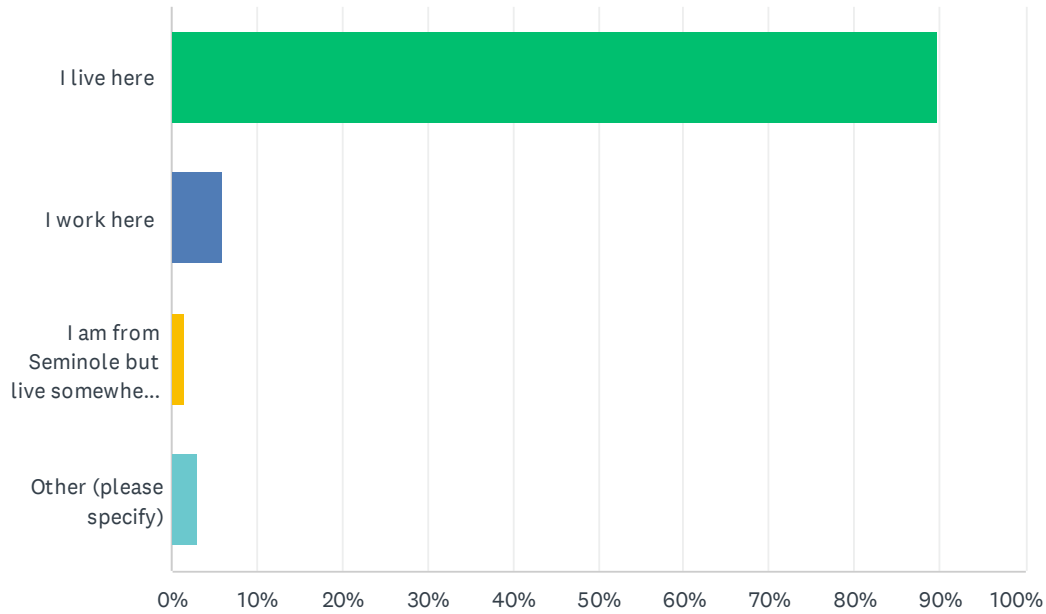

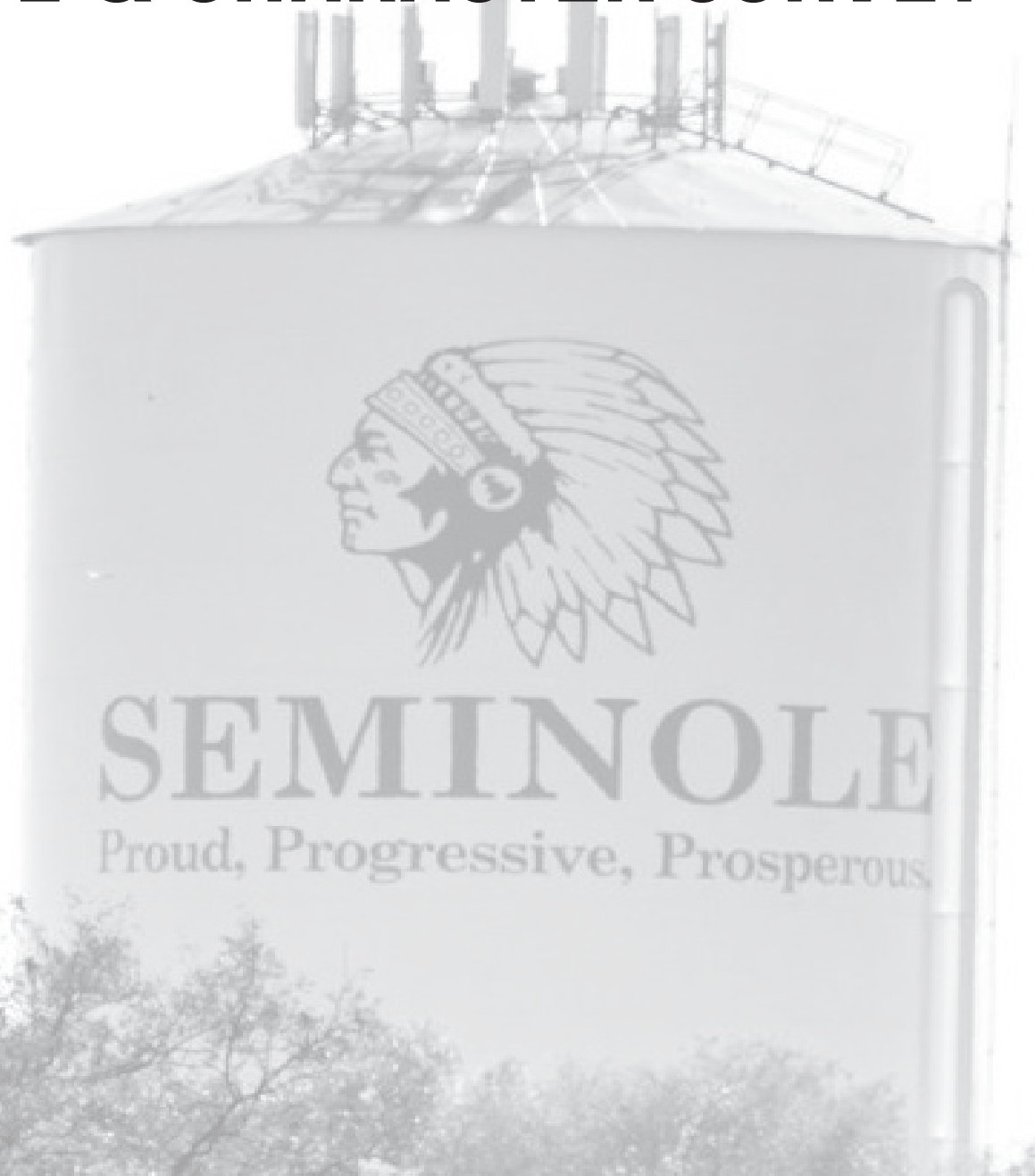

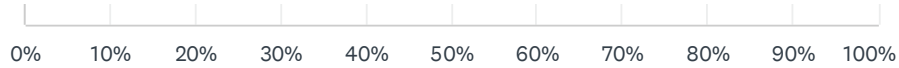

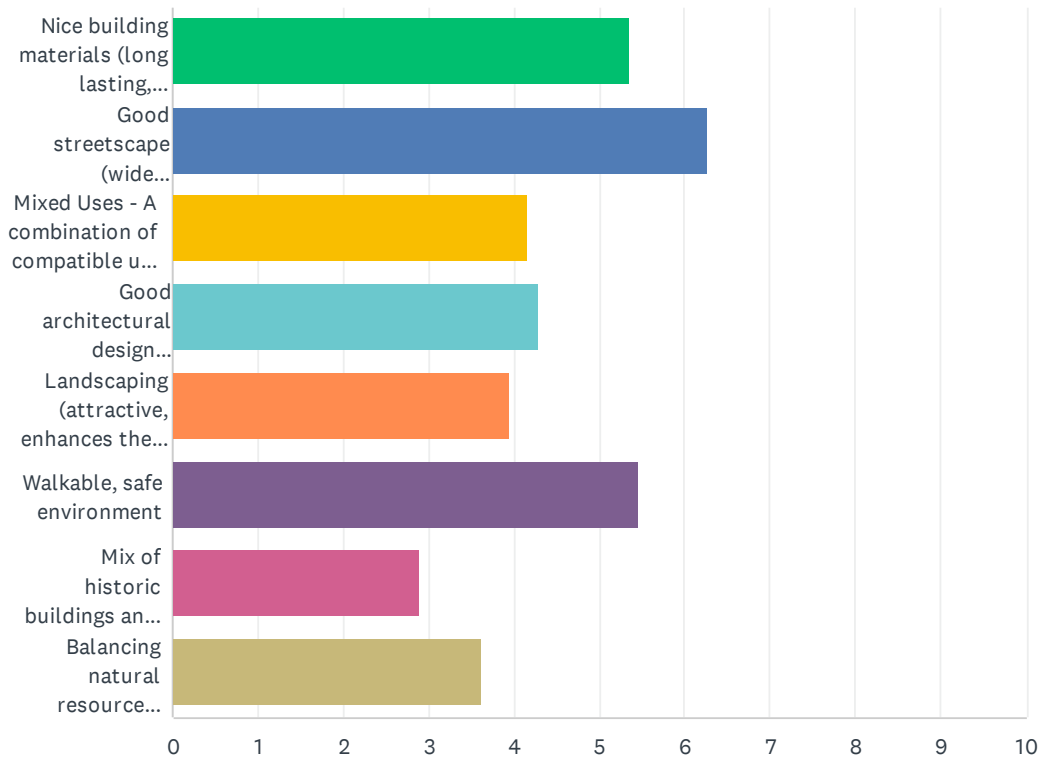

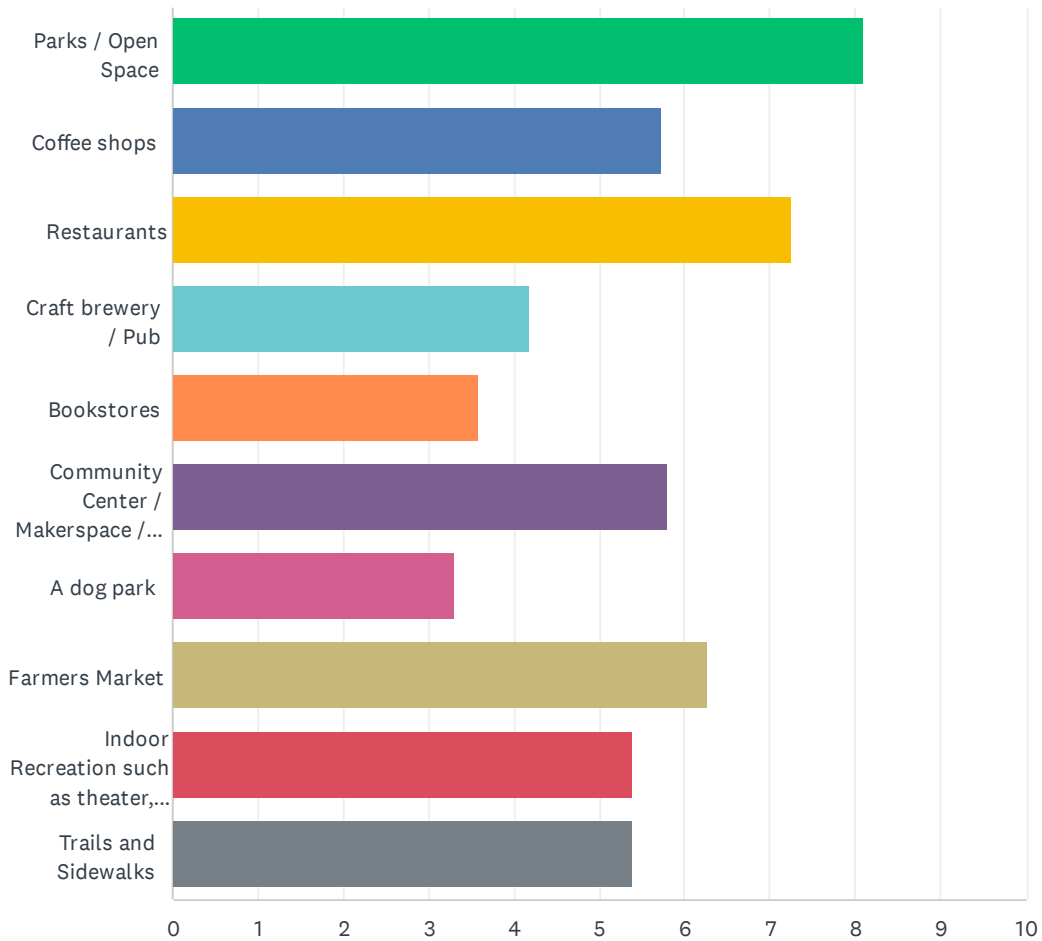

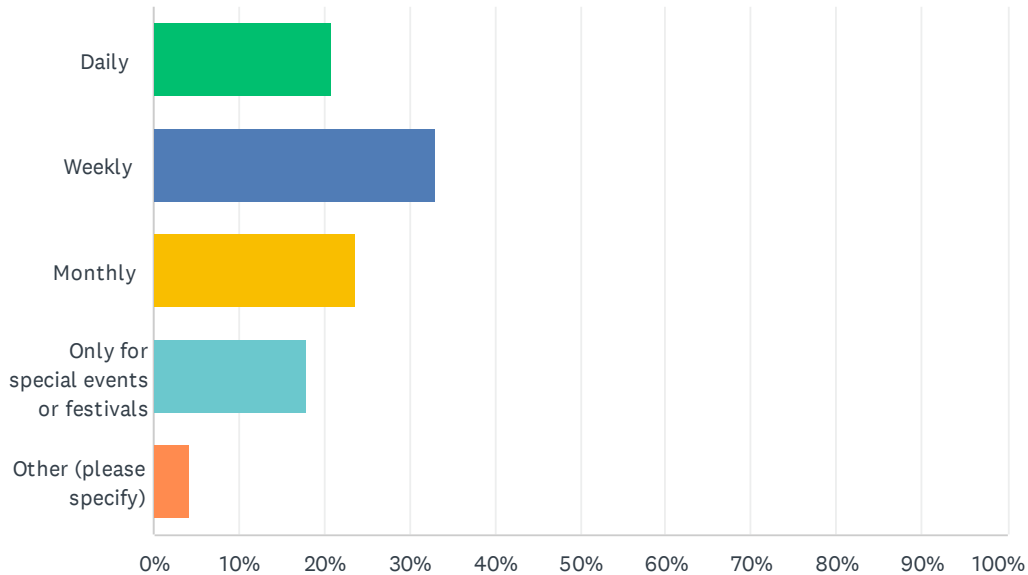

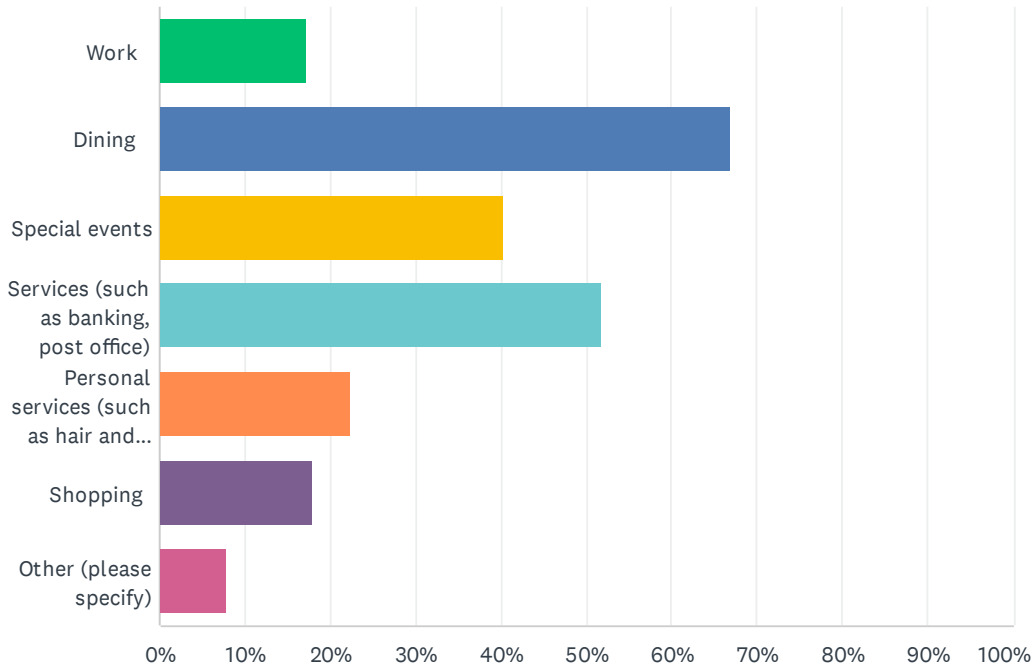

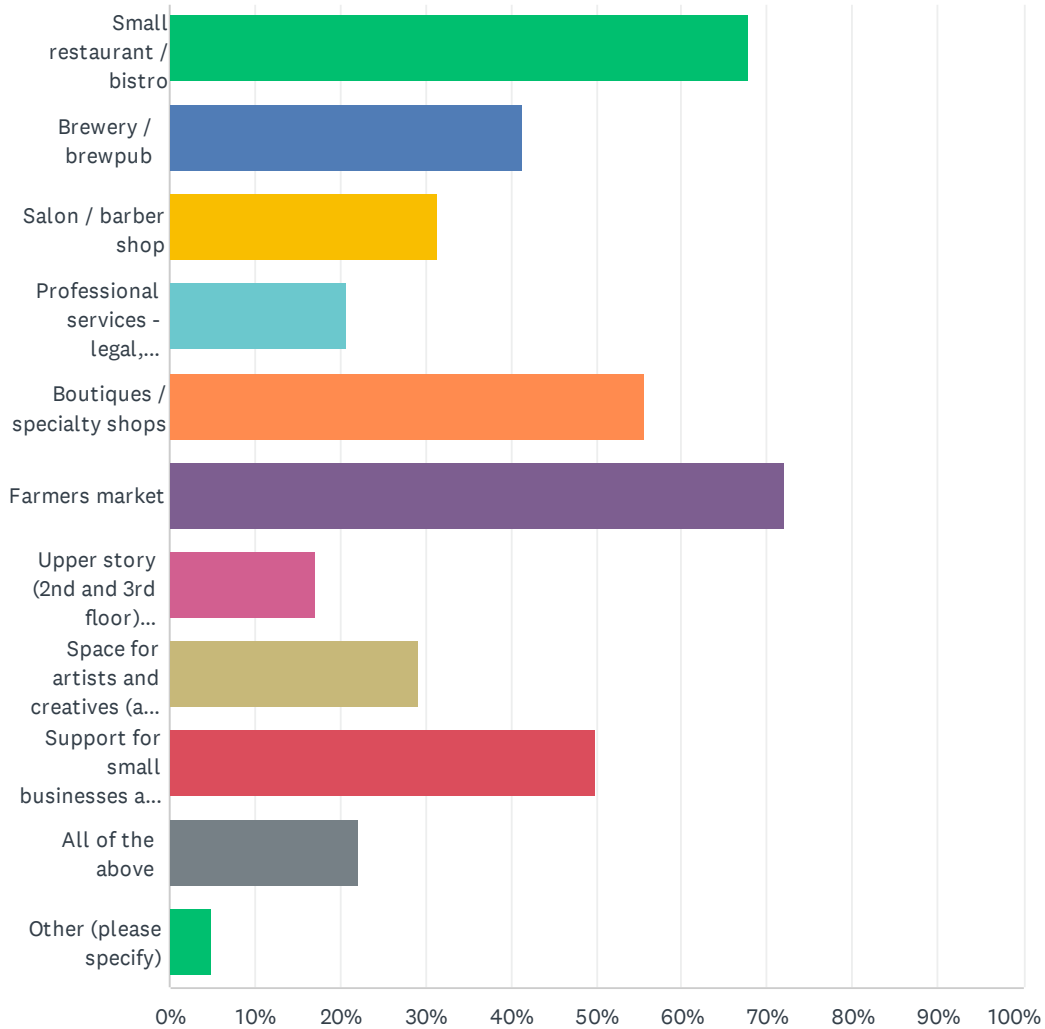

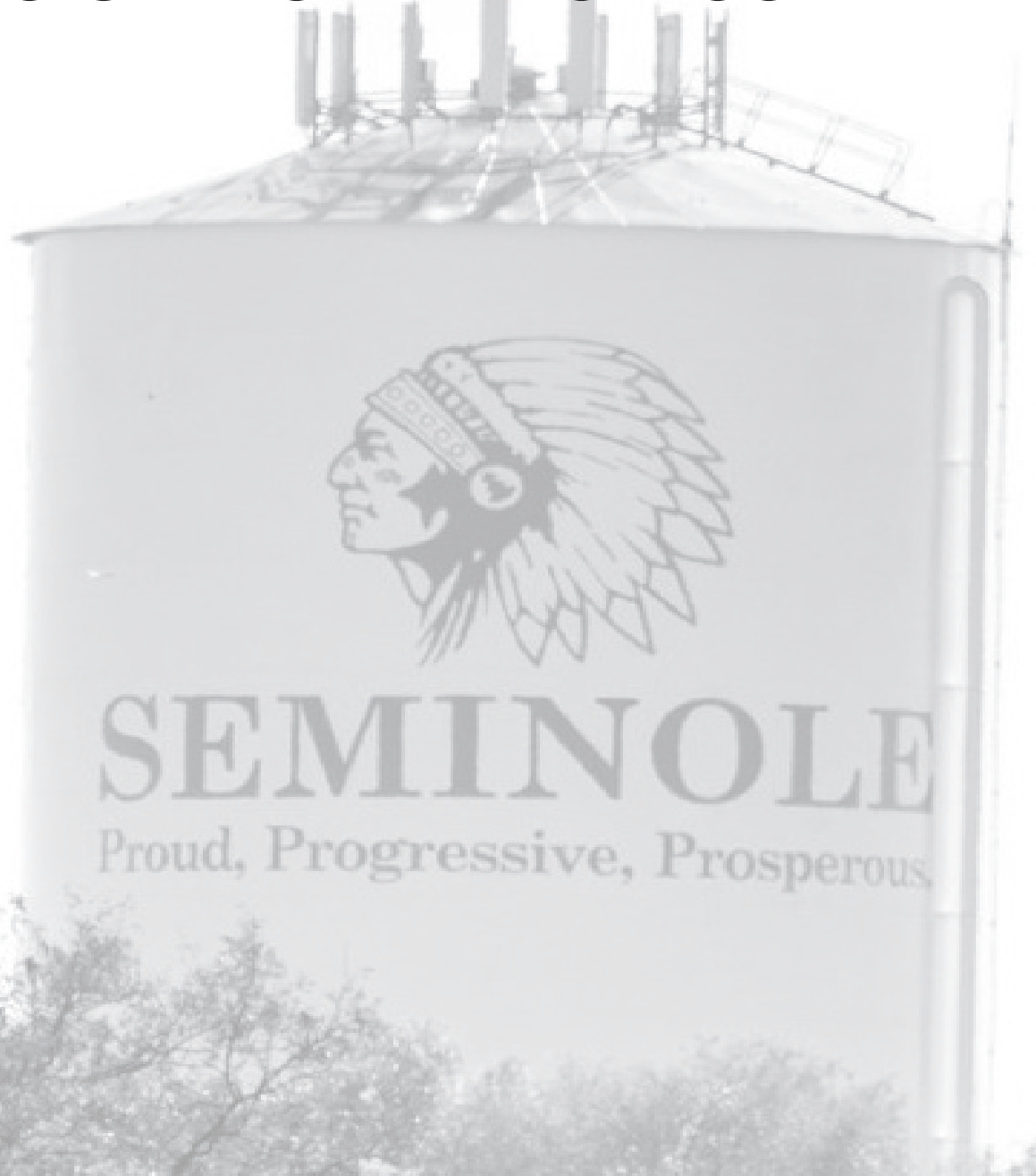

Q1 How often do you visit city parks?

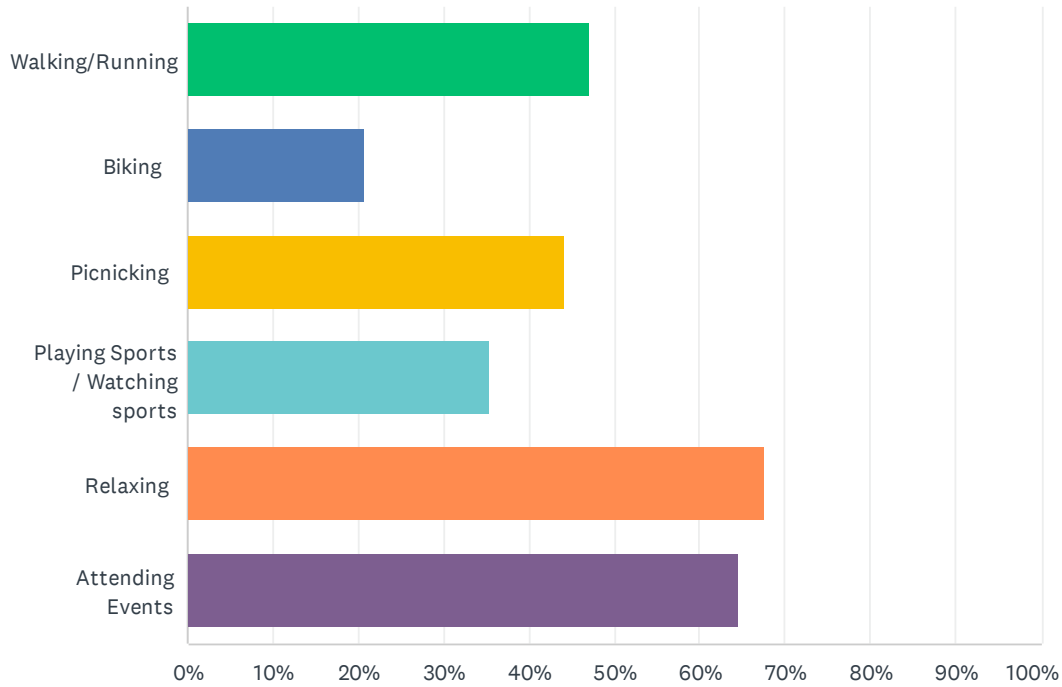

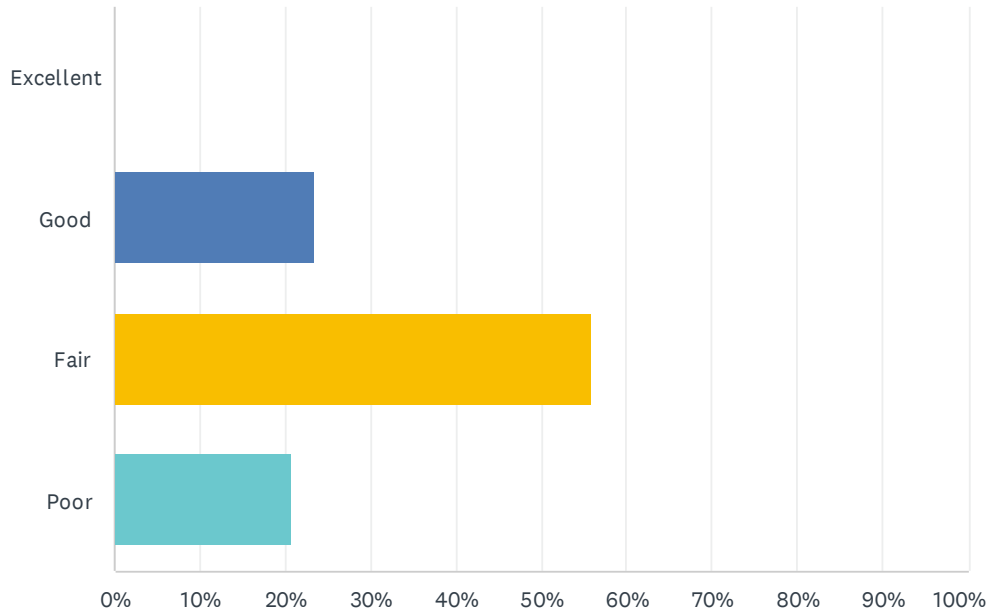

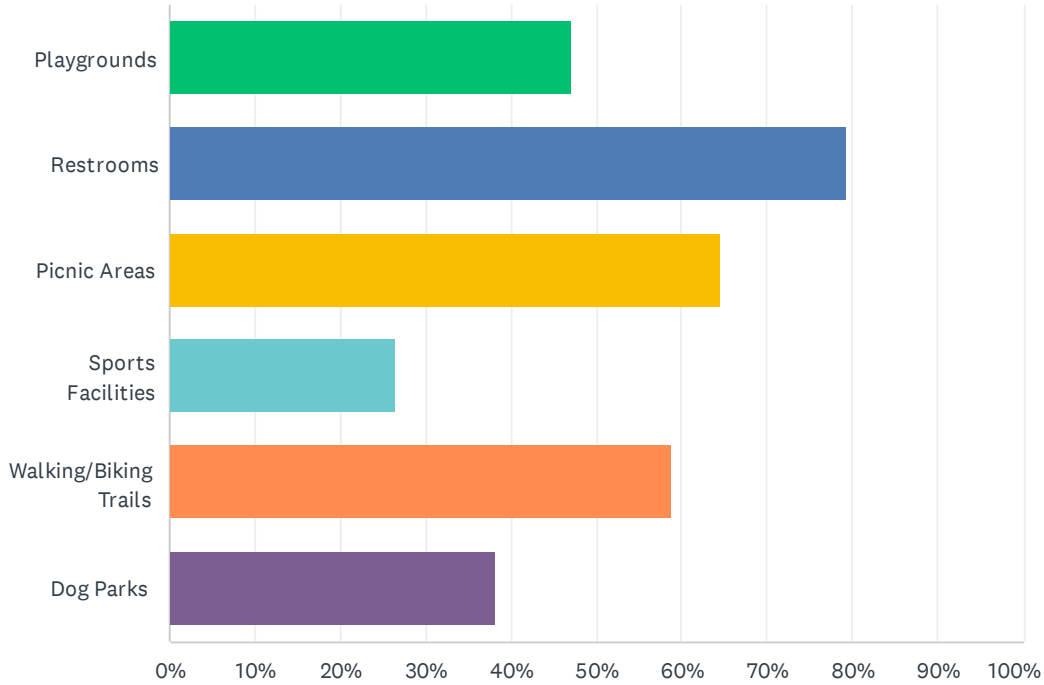

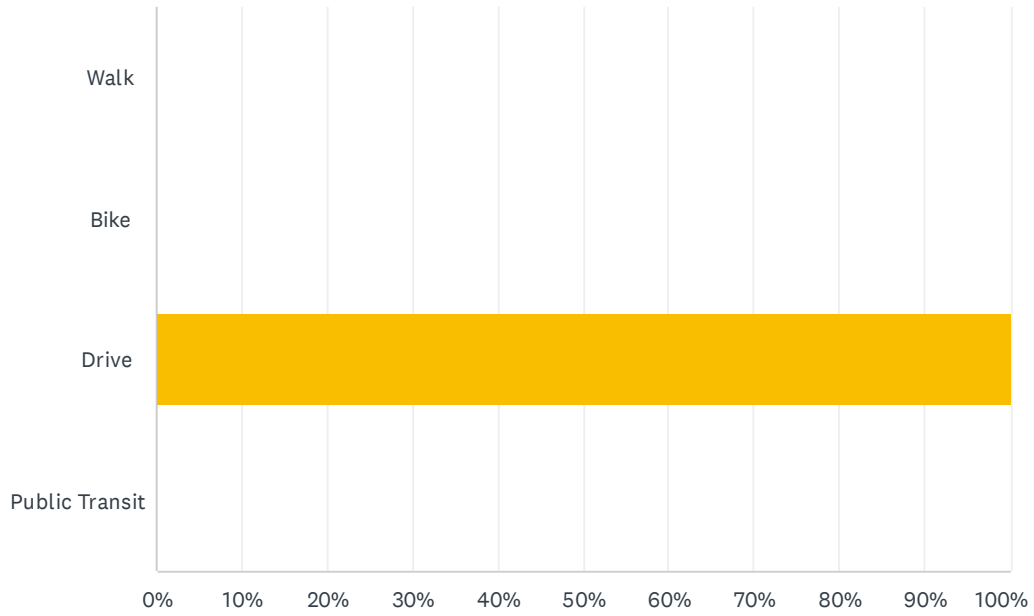

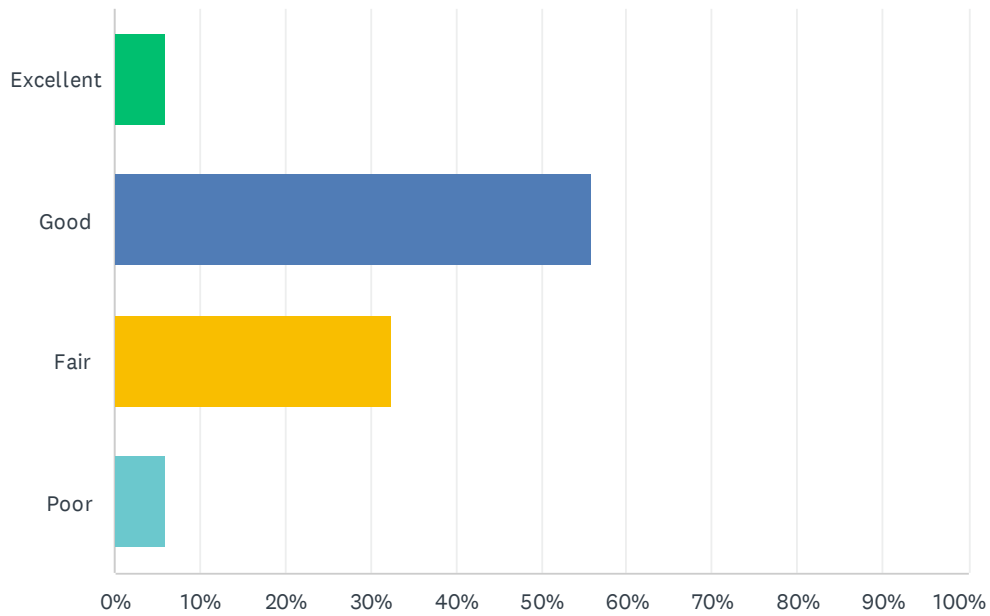

Q8 How would you rate the accessibility of the city parks?

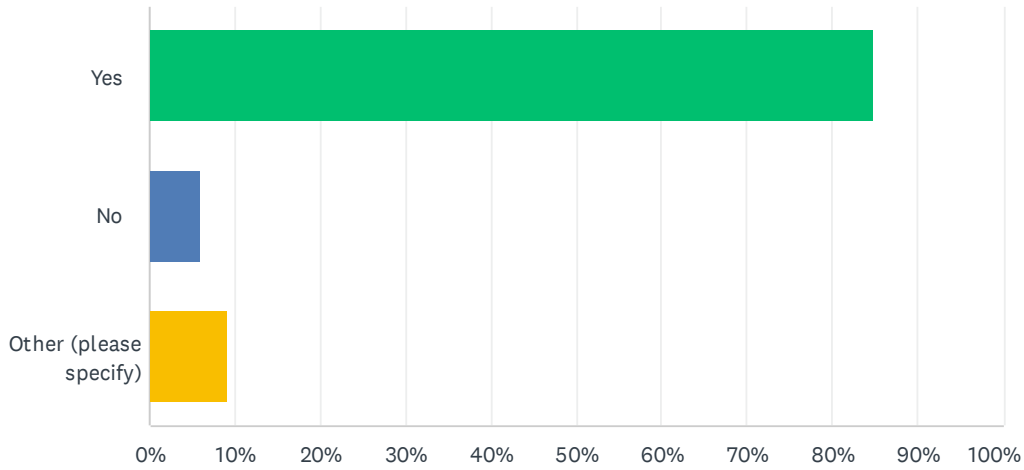

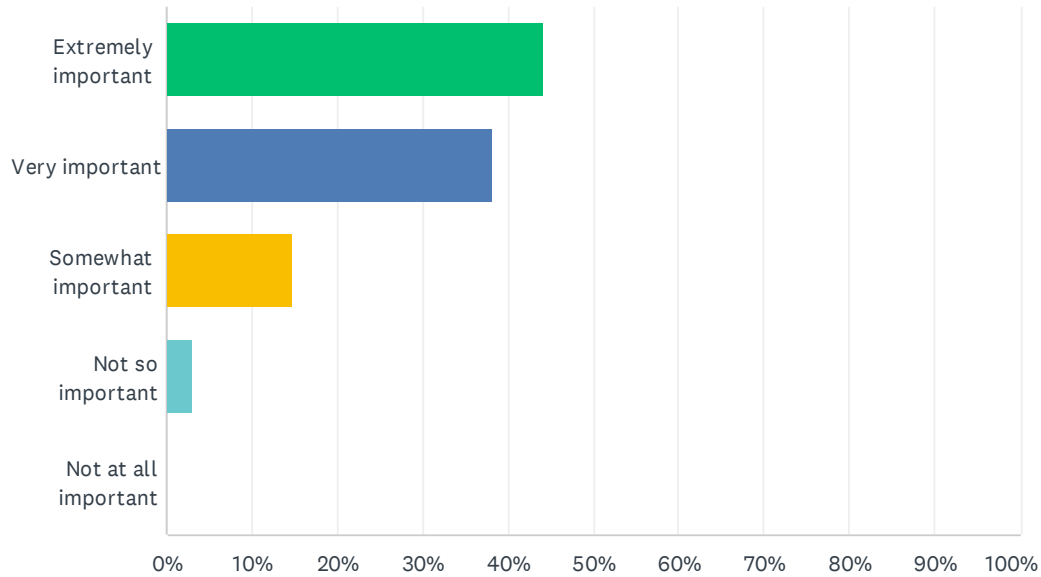

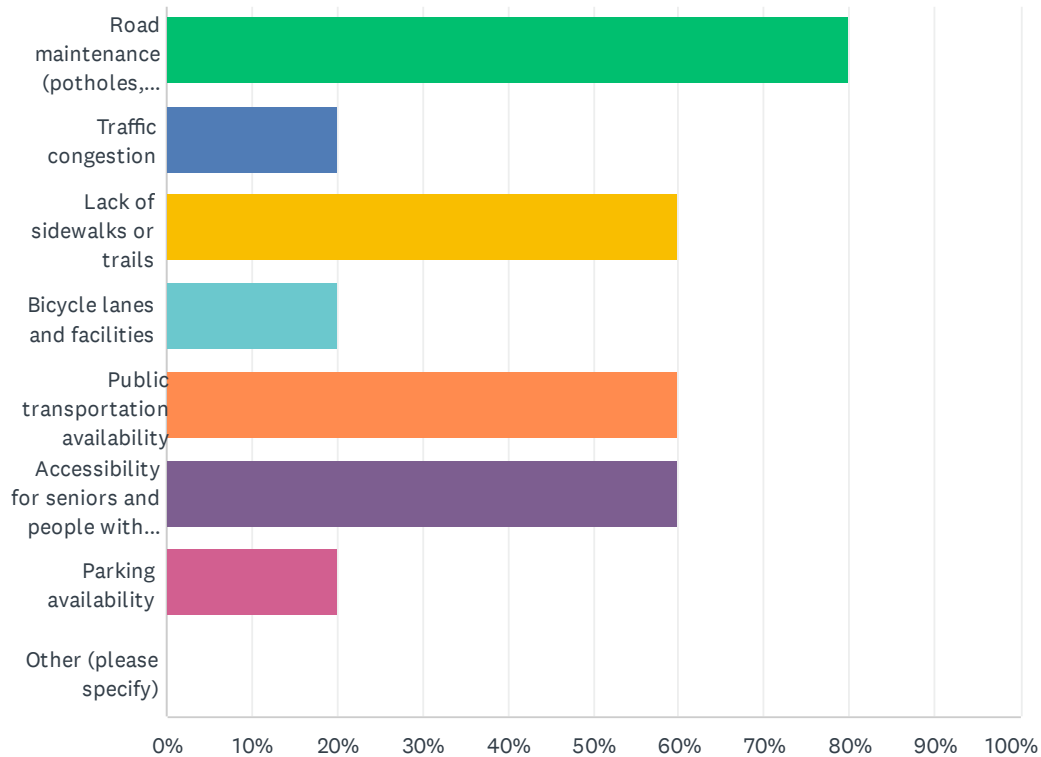

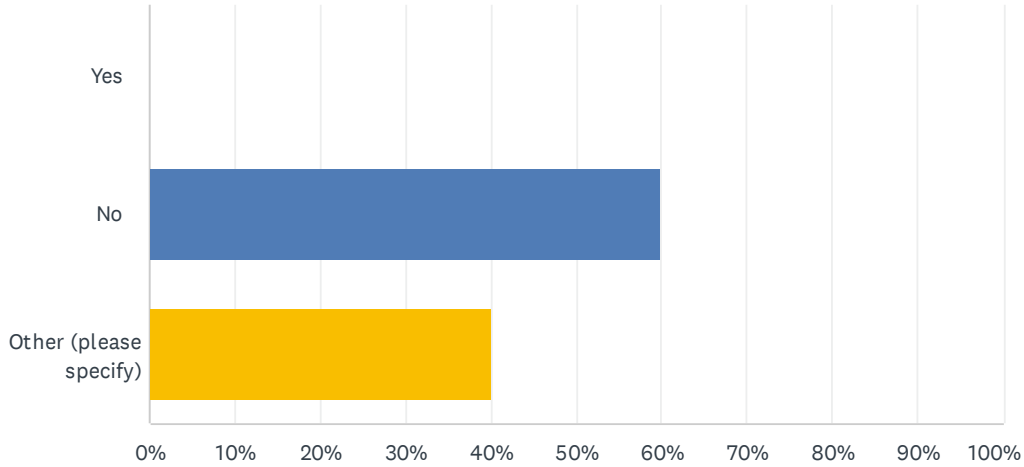

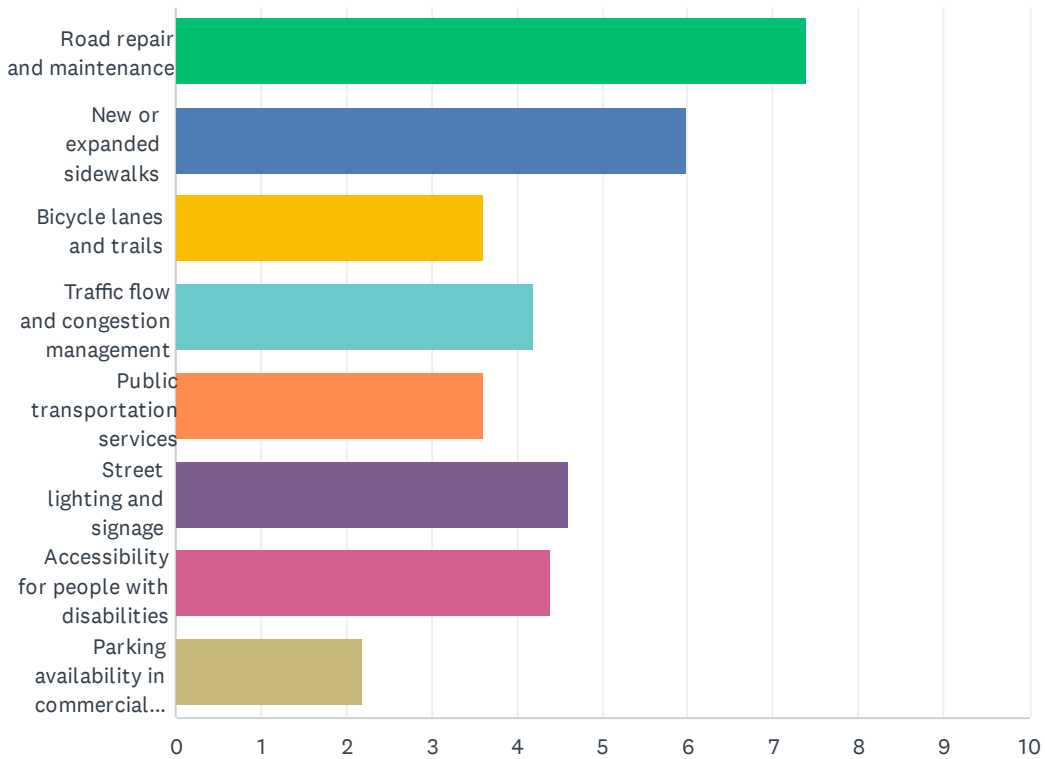

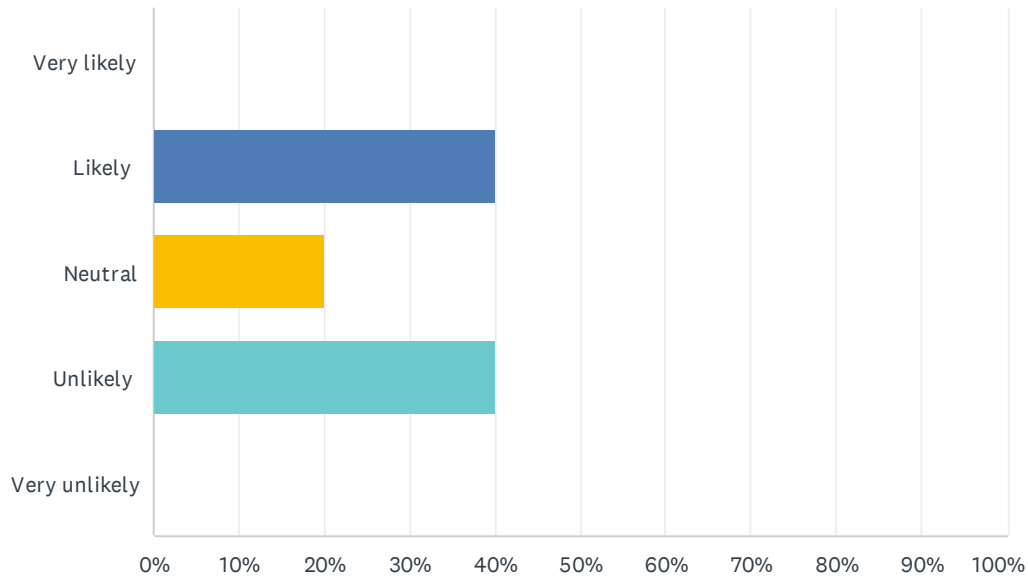

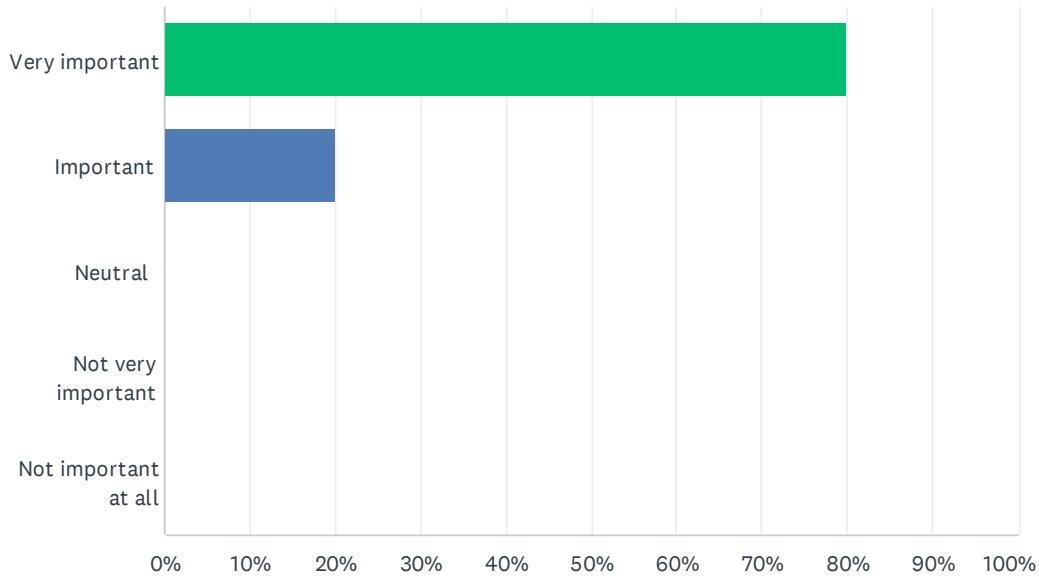

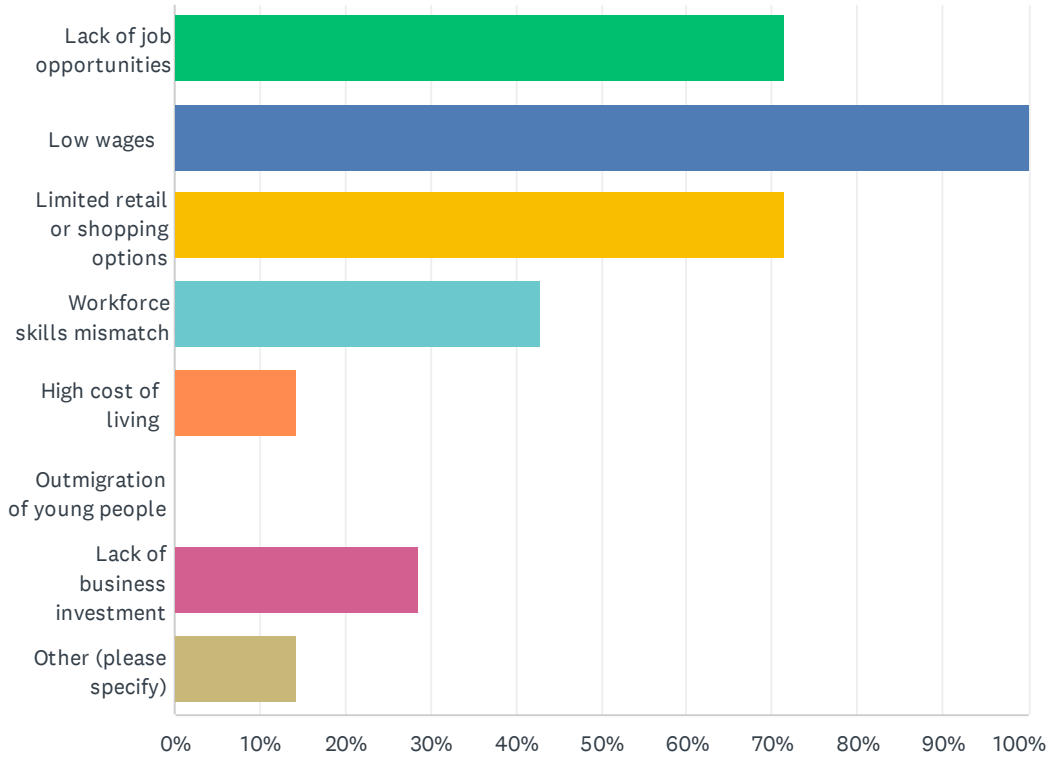

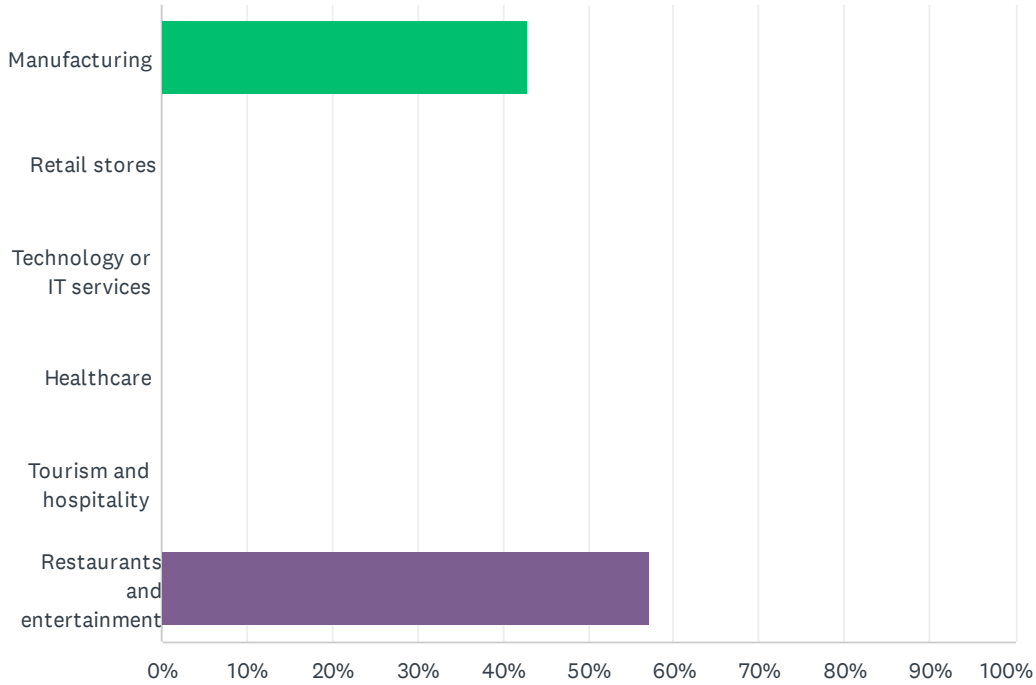

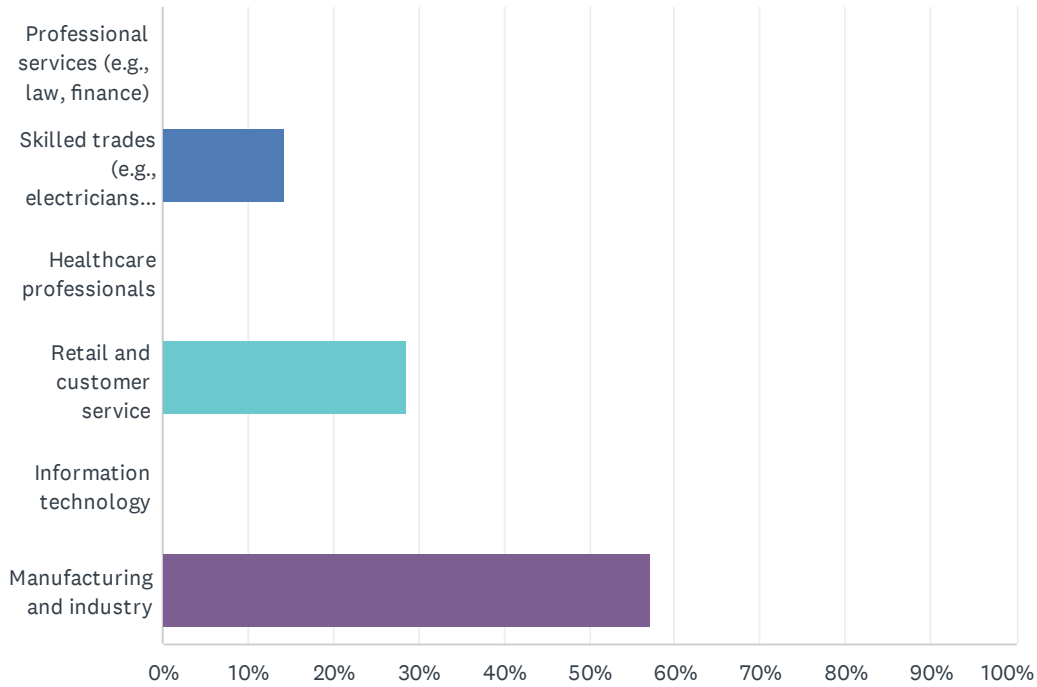

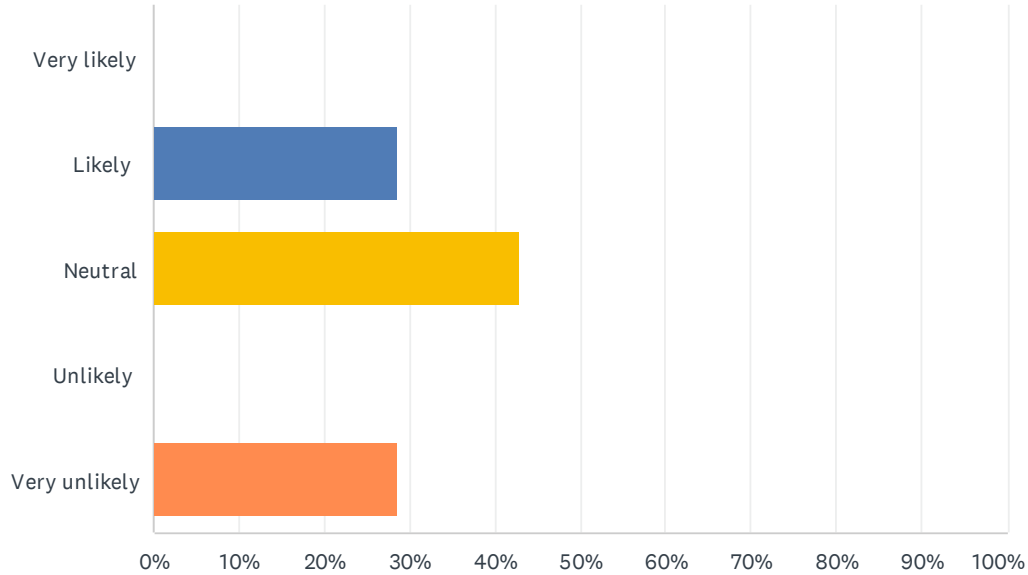

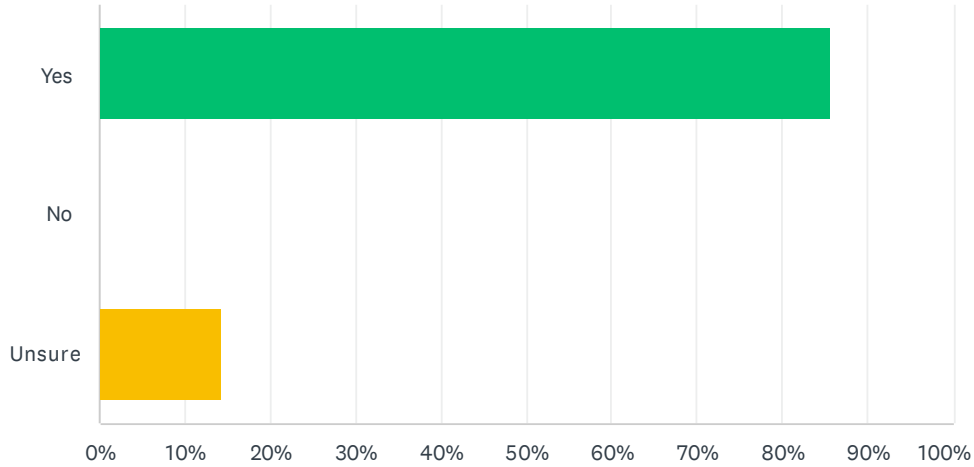

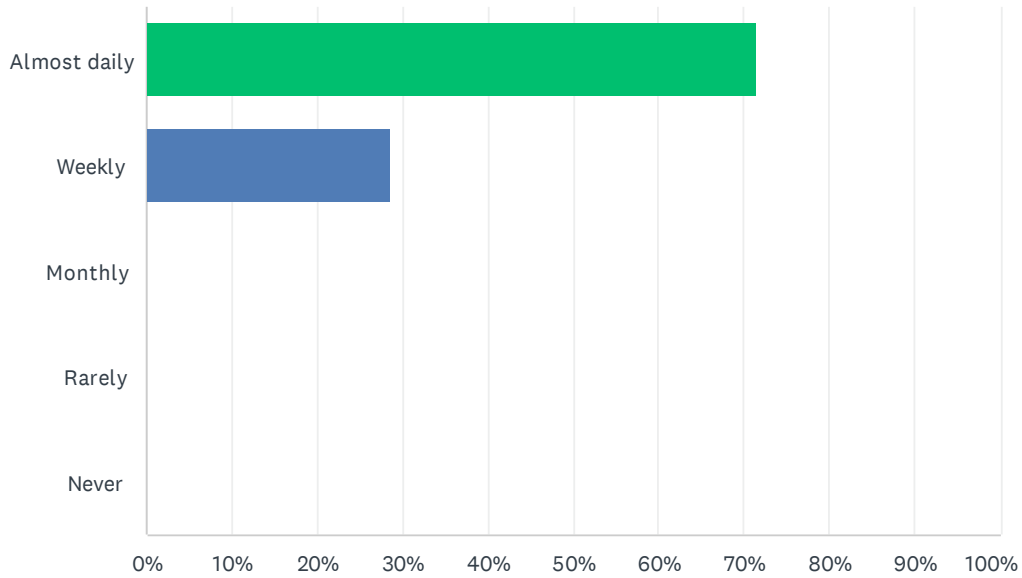

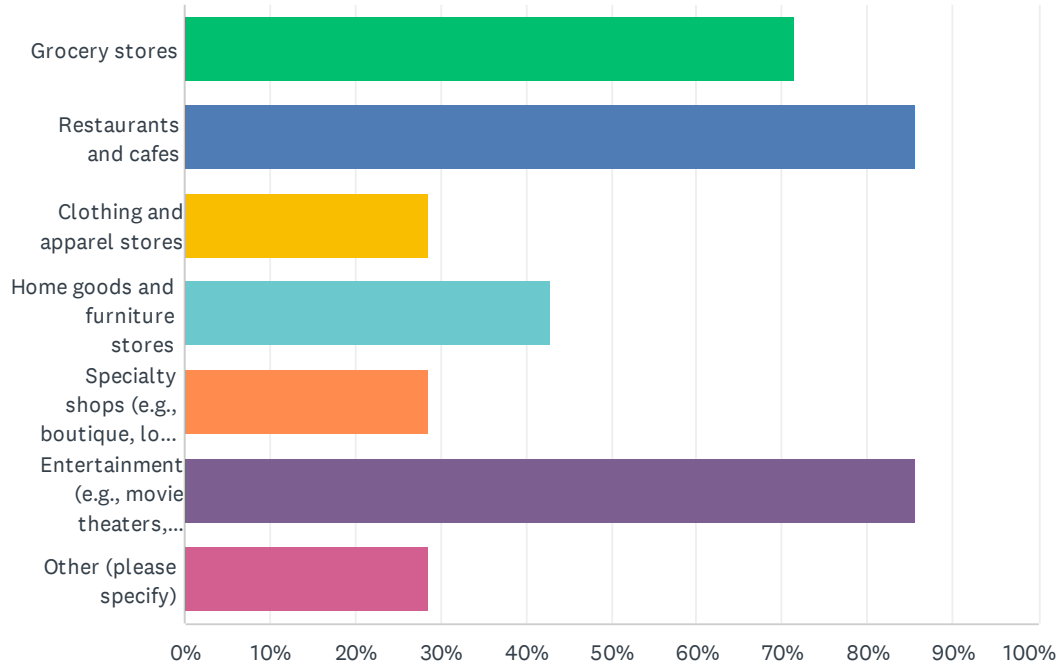

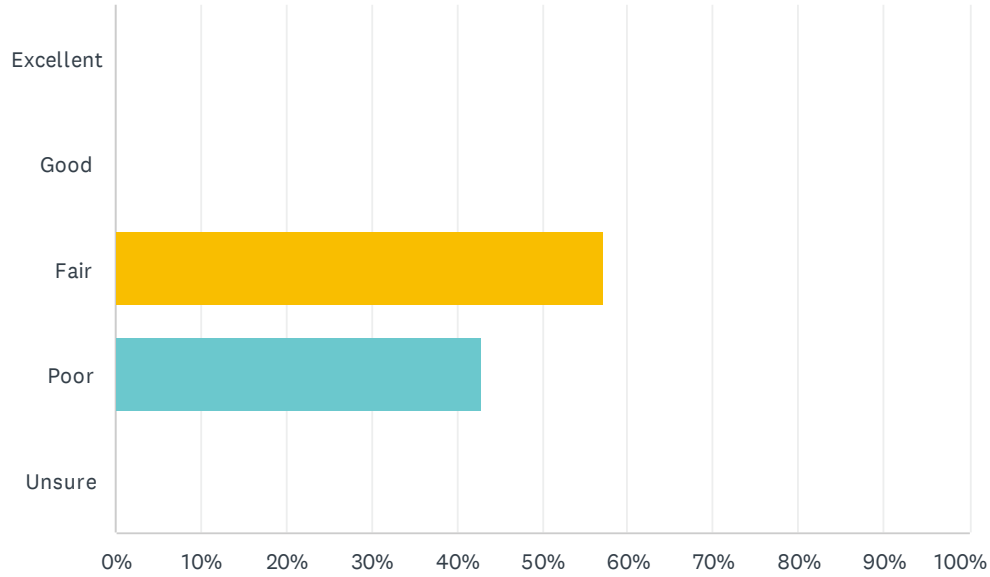

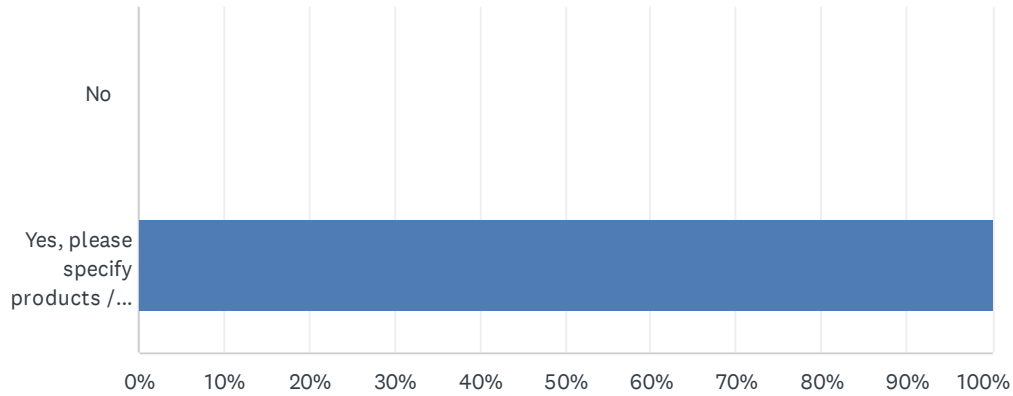

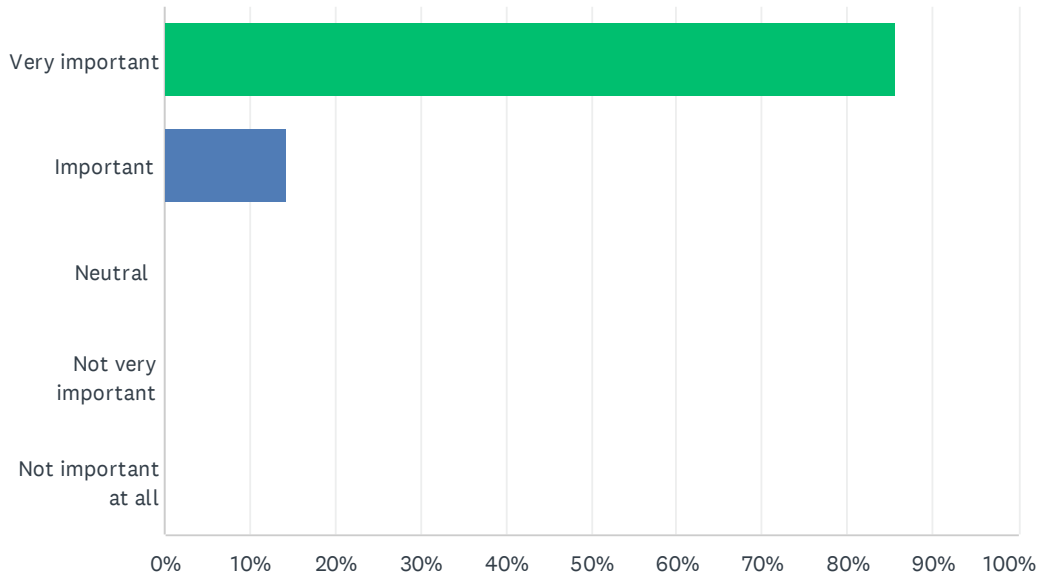

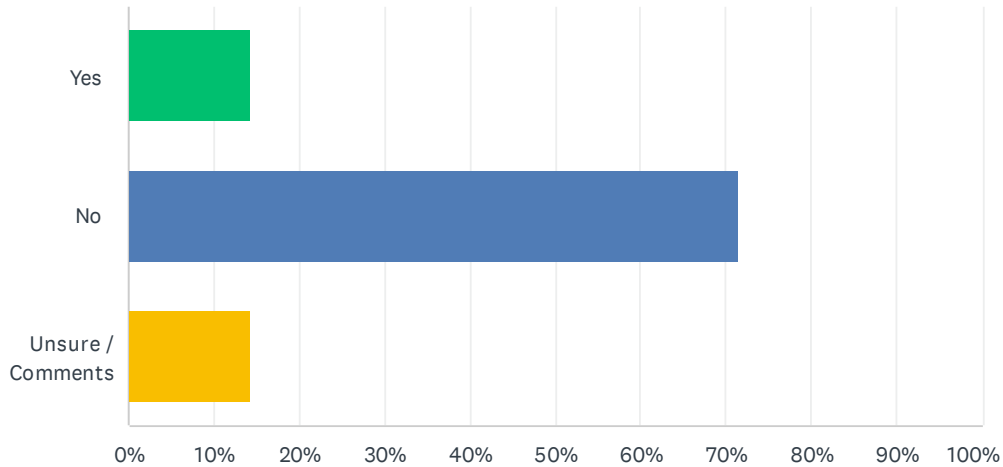

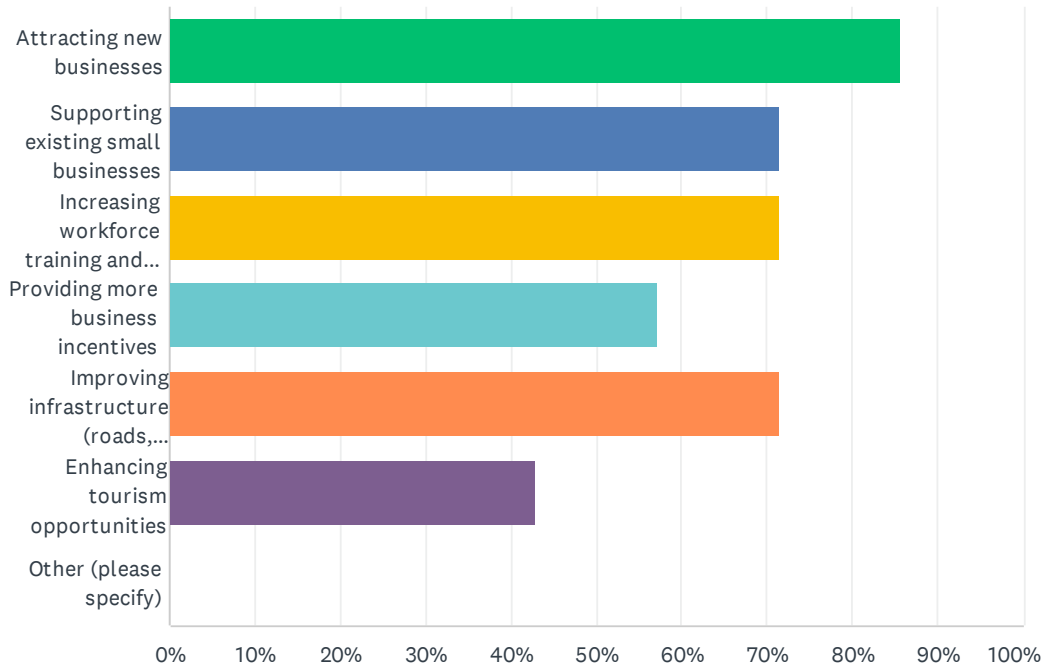
